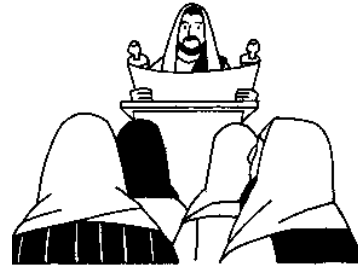

A Prophet's Calling....



A prophet is only despised in his own country among his own relations & in his own house.

A prophet is a messenger sent by God to call His people back to true worship & adoration of the Lord God. A prophet's task is to warn, admonish, even threaten the Lord's People about their behaviour; but also to encourage, console & calm their fears & concerns. Often unwelcomed, even scorned & despised, the prophet nevertheless feels impelled to bring to the Lord's chosen People the message they have been entrusted with. Usually, the prophet suffers greatly in this Mission, enduring many hardships & even death in martyrdom.

What lies behind the prophet's task is the love the Lord God has for His People. As our Good Shepherd, the Lord God cares passionately about the welfare & safety of the flock of His People. Each & every age discovers that the Lord has provided new & different prophets to speak to His People. The Church also carries out this prophetic role; in reminding us of the love of God, what He has already taught us, & how He wishes us to follow Him as disciples by implementing His law in our lives.
