THE TRIUMPH (EXALTATION) OF THE HOLY CROSS

"In this sign, conquer!"



The Roman Emperor, Constantine, experienced a vision just before going into battle at the Milvian Bridge. In the dream he beheld the symbol of the Cross of Jesus & heard the words, "In this Sign Conquer!" The Emperor attributed his later success in battle to the Christian God & converted to Christianity bringing protection for the Church by the Empire with him. The age of persecution for the early Christians drew to a close. Although the Cross of Christ is an instrument of suffering, torture & death, it is through the same Cross that the Crucified One becomes the Risen conquering Lord when He rises from the tomb.
